### General Information – Entry Requirements

1. Copies of support documentation for all accomplishments and titles **must be uploaded to Zooza** before you submit your entry for all entries in the Sieger, Champion or Working classes, and for Breed Surveys. (BST's and BSC's)
2. Your dog's original registration, hip certification and support documents for all accomplishments and titles **MUST** be available at the show for inspection at the time of check-in and/or the beginning of the class.
4. **A valid Hip Certification, pass or fail is required on all dogs over the age of 30 months.**
5. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

## Additional Show Information

ROTTWEILER CLUB OF CONNECTICUT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAR ENTRY, REFUSE FURTHER PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT AND/OR REMOVE/ HAVE REMOVED ANY EXHIBITOR(S), SPECTATOR(S), THEIR GUESTS AND/ OR THEIR DOG(S) FROM THE SHOW GROUNDS FOR ANY REASON.

When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. Photocopies of support documents for all titles and accomplishments must be sent with entry; original documents must be available for inspection at the show. This is a German style conformation show.

- The decision of the Judge is final.
- No dog shall be permitted to enter any class with missing teeth.
- Dogs are shown in a natural stance (no hand stacking) and may be baited with toys at the judge's discretion. Baiting with food is generally prohibited by the judges.
- Double handling is permitted and encouraged.
- Adult classes will be moved (run) long enough for the judge to evaluate dogs' movement and fitness. You may change handlers as needed.
- Event will be held outdoors, rain or shine.
- Bring your own chairs and anything else you may deem necessary for comfort for you and your dogs.
- **No dogs will be allowed within 50 feet of the show ring except those who are entered in the class that is being judged.**
- **No dogs may be tied out at show site or ringside. Please have a crate for each dog. No X-pens are allowed,**
- Please do not bring non-entered dogs to the show grounds.
- Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them.
- Dress is informal, sports attire is customary.
- Only Rottweilers with a valid USRC recognized registration (from AKC, CKC, USRC, or any FCI member Kennel Club) may participate
- Great food and beverages will be available at the show site Saturday and Sunday.

### Adult Classes:

- **Champion Male/Female** (For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a USRC recognized Championship (AKC, CKC or a FCI member kennel club)
- **Working Male/Female** (For all Rottweilers 24 months and older with a USRC recognized SchH/VPK/IPO title).
- **Sieger/Siegerin Class** (For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Sieger/ Siegerin title at a USRC National or Regional Sieger show or have been awarded the USRC Universal Sieger/in title).

### **Non-Regular Classes**

- **Veteran Male/Female** (For all Rottweilers 7 years or older on the day of the show. Veteran class entries are not eligible for titles and receive only critiques, no ratings or placements.
- **Kennel Group** (Three or more dogs bred by the kennel owner and registered with the kennel name of the entrant. All dogs must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry.

**A USRC recognized working title, plus a breed test and USRC registration is required to be named Regional Sieger or Siegerin.**

## Meet our Judge: Lucy Ang, USRC Judge



Lucy Ang lives in Central California and has owned and bred Rottweilers for over forty years.

She has trained and titled three Rottweilers and one German Shepherd Dog to SchH/IGP3, and several others to lesser titles.

She has handled sixteen Rottweilers to the BST/ZtP, fifteen of which were from her own breeding.

Two Rottweilers from her breeding achieved the Advanced Breed Test (ABST/Korung). She has been a member of USRC since 1991 and a judge since 2001.

She has judged throughout the US and also in Canada, Mexico, and Argentina.

## BSC Information and Entry Requirements

### Copies of all documents must be uploaded to Zooza

- ❖ A USRC recognized registration certificate. (USRC, AKC, FCI, CKC).
- ❖ The dog must be tattooed or microchipped.
- ❖ Minimum age to enter the BSC is 15 months.
- ❖ A BH title is not required to earn a BSC, but if the dog has a BH then a copy of scorebook showing titles earned, scorebook number, and full name of dog must be submitted.
- ❖ If available, USRC recognized Hip, Elbow, Cardiac and/or JLPP Certification must be submitted (These health certifications are not required for the BSC but will be included on the certificate if available). Dogs without all health certifications will be designated as "Conforms to the Breed Standard" but are not designated as breedable. \*\*All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on all health certifications\*\*
- ❖ Copy of any prior BSC attempts.
- ❖ Weight Certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
- ❖ If your dog is registered with USRC a USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and health certification(s) if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.
- ❖ Bitches in season may participate; provided they are kept apart from the rest of the participants and they must be presented last.
- ❖ Pregnant or nursing females are not permitted to participate.
- ❖ Spayed bitches may be presented for certification. Neutered males may be presented provided the dog has received a show critique from a USRC show as evidence that the dog's testicles were present prior to neutering.
- ❖ Dog may only be presented once per scheduled certification. There is no waiting period between attempts for dogs that

## ZTP (BST) Information and Entry Requirements

### Copies of all documents must be uploaded to Zooza.

- ❖ The dog must be registered with USRC prior to the entry closing date. (Registration with AKC, CKC, or any FCI member Kennel Club is required for USRC Registration).
- ❖ The dog must have a USRC recognized BH upon check in for the Breed Test. If the BH is earned after the close of entries a copy of the scorebook showing the BH title must be presented to the ZTP secretary upon check in on the day of the breed test
- ❖ The dog must be tattooed or microchipped.
- ❖ The owner and the handler of the dog must be USRC members.
- ❖ The dog must have a weight certificate (if requested by the host club) dated within 30 days of the test date.
- ❖ Copies of USRC membership cards for owners and handlers, copies of the entered dog's USRC registration and health certificates must be submitted with the dog's entry. The originals of all of these documents must be presented to the secretary upon check in. A copy of the entered dog's USRC Registration Certificate will be accepted as proof of titles and health certifications provided all required information is on the Registration Certificate. \*\* All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on all health certifications\*\*
- ❖ The dog must have a USRC recognized hip rating and must be rated as OFA excellent, good, or fair, ADRK HD-, HD +/-, HD+, or FCI HD A or B
- ❖ The dog must have a USRC recognized elbow rating and the elbows must be rated as OFA Normal, Grade I or Grade II, ADRK ED-, ED+/-, ED+ or FCI ED 0 or ED 1.
- ❖ The dog must have an OFA normal cardiac certificate
- ❖ The dog must have an OFA JLPP certificate
- ❖ The only collar allowed is a fur saver.
