Tails on natural tailed dogs will be judged using the FCI Standard. *There are no AKC points or recognized AKC titles at this show.* You do not have to be a member of ARC to enter.

JUDGE: Kimberly Cardona (AKC - USA)

Kimberly Cardona is a certified licensed American Kennel Club Judge for working breeds, vice-president of ARC. She is a breeder, trainer and handler of 40 years. Her kennel Vom Drakkenfels which is located in Florida has produced several champions with some Best in Shows, Best in Specialty show, and multiple dog in Top 20 dogs in the US. Her kennel has also produced 2 FCI International Champion Rottweilers which includes the first American Bred male to ever accomplish this title. She produced many working High in trial winners because of her belief in a well-balanced dog.



JUDGE: Anton "Toni" Spindler (ADRK – Germany)



Since 1996 I have judged more than 30,000 dogs worldwide at FCI/VDH shows and sporting trials. I was a judge at the FCI World Show 2022 Sao Paulo (Brazil). For decades I have regularly judged at the biggest shows in the world (World Shows, Bundessieger and Europasieger Shows Club Winner Shows, etc). I have judged over decades multiple times at sporting trials, as well as at German and World Championship for Rottweilers and Dobermans for IGP and Tracking.

I have judged all over the world on all continents in over 50 countries, Including: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bolivia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Columbia, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic,

Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Ghana, Greece, Hungary, Honduras, India, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Mexico, Netherlands, Nigeria, Norway, Philippines, Poland, Romania, Russia, San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, United Kingdom, and USA.

I have presented my dogs myself at shows without exception in all parts and have successfully passed over 300 sporting trials. I was a show director and organizer at club winner shows (including over 60 dogs!) and special breed shows. At sporting trials and German Championships, I was the trial director/organizer.

Under the kennel name "Von der Zirbelnuss" I bred up to the S-Litter.

Breed Standard Evaluations

ARC BSE entries will be accepted first with a max limit of 15 and must meet ARC Mandatory Practices and ARC rules. If the max limit is not reached by 6/9/2025, ADRK BSE entries that meet ADRK requirements will be accepted until the max limit of 15 is reached.

REGULAR CLASSES DEFINED

Puppy Classes: 4 to under 6 months – 6 to under 9 months – 9 to under 12 months
Youth Classes: 12 to under 18 months – 18 to under 24 months

OPEN – (15 months and older). Rottweilers that have not yet earned a Championship or Gebrauchshunde Title. A dog eligible to enter the Working Class and/or the Independent Sieger Champion Class may choose to enter the Open Class; however, a dog with a Championship or Gebrauchshunde Title may not. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

CHAMPION* – (15 months and older). This includes American Kennel Club, Canadian Kennel Club, and FCI International Champions of record, as well as any champion of record from a country its Championship was awarded by an FCI recognized kennel club. Select or Sieger awards are not titles. Once a dog has a Championship title, he may not enter the Open Class. However, he may choose to enter any other class that his titles and eligibility allows. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

WORKING* – (15 months and older) Rottweilers that have earned a minimum of one of the following American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club titles: Companion Dog (CD); Herding Started (HS); Novice Agility (NA); Rally Novice (RN); Tracking Dog (TD). An ARC Carting Started Title (CS) would also meet eligibility requirement. A dog is also eligible if he has earned a Traffic Sure Companion Dog (BH) from DVG, WD, SV, USA, USRC, and other recognized Schutzhund organization. CGC, TT (ATTS), TDI type certifications are not eligible for entry. Dogs that are eligible for this class may choose to enter another class that his titles and eligibility allows instead. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

GEBRAUCHSHUNDE* – (18 months and older) Rottweilers that have earned a SchH I, IPO I, VPG I, IGP I, or foreign country equivalent. Dogs that are eligible for this class may not enter the Working class, but may choose to enter any other class that his titles and eligibility allows instead. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

INDEPENDENT SIEGER CLUB CHAMPION* – (15 months and older). Rottweilers with the United States Rottweiler Club (USRC) Championship, United Rottweiler Klub of America (URKA) Championship, or URKA Elite Championship title. Dogs that are eligible for the Champion class, have the URKA Youth Champion title, or have only a Youth Sieger/in or Sieger/in title are not eligible for this class. Dogs eligible for this class may choose to enter any other class that their titles and eligibility allows instead. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

* **NOTICE:** For classes with eligibility requirements (marked with asterisk*: Champion, Working, Gebrauchshunde and Independent Sieger Club Champion), copies of support documents for titles **MUST** be included with entry. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

VETERAN (JUNIOR) – Rottweilers must be at least 7 years, but not yet 9 years. A dog is eligible to enter this class regardless of what titles he has earned or what other classes he may be eligible for. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in this class. The Junior Veteran Dog and Bitch winners are eligible to compete for Sieger/Siegerin. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

VETERAN (SENIOR) Rottweilers 9 years & older – A dog is eligible to enter this class regardless of what titles he has earned or what other classes he may be eligible for. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in this class. The Senior Veteran Dog and Bitch winners are eligible to compete for Sieger/Siegerin. If at the time of a show entry the dog's HD/ED rating is not provided, then the HD/ED field will state "no listing".

NON-REGULAR CLASSES DEFINED

The Kennel Group, Stud Dog, and Brood Bitch winners are not eligible to compete for Sieger/Siegerin

Kennel Group – An entry of at least three (3) dogs registered with the same kennel name. The group will be judged for consistency of breed type, structure, temperament, movement and merit. Only placements 1-4 will be awarded. No written critiques are given. All dogs must be entered and exhibited in a regular class. A separate entry form must be used for the entry of each dog.

Stud Dog – The class consists of the stud dog and at least two (up to five) of his offspring. The stud dog is examined for disqualifying faults and his offspring are examined for breed type, structure, temperament, movement and merit. The stud dog is judged on his ability to produce consistency throughout the entries. Only placements 1-4 are awarded. No written critiques are given. All offspring must be entered and exhibited in a regular class. A separate entry form must be used for the entry of each dog.

Brood Bitch – The class consists of the brood bitch and at least two (up to five) of her offspring. The brood bitch is examined for disqualifying faults and her offspring are examined for breed type, structure, temperament, movement and merit. The brood bitch is judged on her ability to produce consistency throughout the entries. Only placements 1-4 are awarded. No written critiques are given. All offspring must be entered and exhibited in a regular class. A separate entry form must be used for the entry of each dog.

JUNIOR HANDLER INFORMATION

The purpose of the Junior Handler (JH) classes is to educate and give the young people of our sport a chance to learn more about their dogs and to practice and see their handling skills in a new and exciting venue and point of view. Judging is on the presentation and basic age-appropriate knowledge of the breed. The quality of the dog is not decisive.

1. JH will compete in two age categories and must compete in the class category based on the junior's age on the day of the show.
 - a. Young Junior Handler Class: 10 to under 14 years, and
 - b. Youth Junior Handler Class: 14 to under 17 years.
2. The dog of the JH need not be entered to exhibit in the show however it must be registered by the AKC or FCI recognized country kennel club and not younger than 12 months old.

3. There will be one first place winner awarded in each age division. The two winners will not compete against each other.
4. Juniors in the class will receive a critique on their handling ability and award of participation.
5. Points the JH Judge will consider:
 - a. Good contact and relationship with the dog;
 - b. Attention to Judge's directions;
 - c. Showing the dog's teeth;
 - d. Use of ring and good tempo and control when moving dog;
 - e. Offering a comprehensive view of the dog to the Judge (don't stand between dog and judge);
 - f. Ability to handle possible problems with the dog in a show ring environment; and
 - g. Sportsmanship toward the other exhibitor and spectators.

CONFORMATION SHOW INFORMATION

1. Fur saver collars only.
2. With the exception of the Kennel Group, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Junior Handler classes, no dog may be entered in more than one class.
3. If a dog is eligible for more than one class, the owner may determine which class the dog may be entered.
4. Once a dog is eligible for the Champion or Gebrauchshunde class, the dog may not enter any other class except those stated in 2. above and Veterans, age permitting.
5. Copies of documentation for the Champion, Working, Gebrauchshunde and Independent Sieger Club Champion classes must accompany the entry form.
6. Entries which do not have the required documentation on file at check-in will be moved to the Open class and may receive a critique but will not be eligible for class placement.
7. If a dog achieves a title after the close of entries that makes him/her eligible for a class other than the one that they were originally entered, proof must be presented to the show secretary at least ½ hour prior to the start of that day's judging.
8. If a dog is entered in more than one class, a separate entry form must be completed for each class.
9. In case of an error in regard to age on the entry form, those in the puppy classes or youth classes will be moved to the appropriate age class; however, the show secretary must be notified at least ½ hour prior to the start of that day's judging.
10. Any individual who is currently suspended from participating in AKC or FCI events will not be eligible to enter or show any dogs, including those owned or co-owned by that individual, in an ARC Sieger Show.
11. Regardless of documentation, dogs with missing teeth (other than allowed by the current AKC standard) will be considered a disqualification at an ARC Sieger Show. Broken teeth, still visible in the mouth, will be evaluated at the judge's discretion. Although 1 missing tooth is allowed in the AKC breed standard, it will be at the judge's discretion if a rating or placement will be awarded. A written critique will still be given.
12. All National Sieger Show participants shall be subject, but not limited to, the following rules:
 - a. The use of bite sleeves and/or agitation for protection training is forbidden on hotel and show grounds unless it is specific to an activity that is hosted by ARC.
 - b. Owners/Handlers, whether exhibiting or not, are responsible for keeping their dogs under control at all times and MUST clean up after them on hotel/motel show grounds.
 - c. Dogs must be on leash at all times.
 - d. There will be no bathing of dogs in hotel/motel rooms.
 - e. There will be no dogs staked down or tied to trees.
 - f. Dogs will not be left unsupervised in closed vehicles without proper a/c, ventilation, and water.
 - g. Anyone who violates these rules may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing.

RING PROCEDURE and GUIDELINES

1. The ring steward will call all entries to the class. Absentees are marked in the catalog. The ring stewards and show secretary will keep a marked catalog or Judges Check-In Sheet.
2. All exhibits are presented in a natural stance; no hand-stacking is permissible in any class.
3. "Free stacking" may be used to present the dog using a small toy or ball.
4. Food may not be used for baiting the dog and is not allowed either inside or outside the ring.
5. After the initial examination for dentition and disqualifying faults, a verbal critique is conducted on each class entry and recorded verbatim on the critique form. Positive aspects as well as any faults or deviations from the standard are noted on the critique, such as any missing teeth, pink gums, light eyes, etc.
6. For Rottweilers born in countries where docking is forbidden by law or where a breeder has chosen not to dock, the tail may be left in its natural condition.
7. The tail on natural-tailed dogs will be critiqued using the FCI Standard for the Rottweiler.
8. There will be no judging preference between docked and natural tailed dogs.
9. Once all exhibits are critiqued, the judge will gait (run) each class for ratings and placements.
10. Dogs will be run long enough to allow the judge to completely evaluate gait and structure.
11. Changing runners and double handling from outside of the ring is encouraged.
12. During the gaing process, the judge at his/her discretion may rate an exhibit and declare, "No further judging is required".
13. All remaining exhibits in each class are evaluated for final rating and placement. Placements are first through fourth place with a corresponding rating.
14. The ring steward will mark all placements and ratings in the show catalog or Judges Check-In Sheet before dismissing the class. The judge, when time permits, will sign the critiques after the ratings and placements. The club will retain a copy of all critiques.
15. Judge's decision on the critique and placement is final.
16. Sport casual attire and comfortable running shoes are recommended.

DEFINITIONS, RATINGS and PLACEMENTS

The Placement (1st through 4th) is how the dog compares to the others in that particular class.

The Rating is how the dog compares to the breed standard.

1st to 4th place will be awarded in each class.

Best Male/Female Puppy – First place entries from each of the Puppy Classes. Must be VP-1 rated.

Youth Sieger/Siegerin – First place entries in the Youth Classes. Must be V-1 rated.

Sieger/Siegerin – First place entries in Open, Champion, Working, Gebrauchshunde, Independent Sieger Club Champion, Veteran, including Junior/Senior Veteran Dogs/Bitches. Must be V-1 rated.

Most Beautiful Male and Most Beautiful Female – Selected from the Best Male/Female Puppy, Youth Sieger/Siegerin, and Sieger/Siegerin.

BREED STANDARD EVALUATION (BSE)

The Breed Standard Evaluation (BSE) is a standards evaluation which certifies that the tested dog has met all mandatory health criteria as outlined by the American Rottweiler Club (ARC), is free of disqualifying faults under the AKC standard, and passes temperament/mental testing conducted in a public setting. All outcomes will be documented and certified with the judge's signature. A full critique will be given with results of all testing listed. Results will remain the property of ARC and will be published in the ARK. The original BSE form will be provided to the owner of the dog entered and a copy will remain with the club.

This is not an obedience test and no formal obedience training is necessary to enter or pass. The dog must be leash sure and able to walk in differing situations in control on a leash at the handler's side. The following items **MUST** be sent in with the BSE entry (NO EXCEPTIONS).

- Microchip number or permanent tattoo ID must be listed on entry form and will be checked on day of event
- AKC registration certificate with the current owner's name listed.
- Weight certificate dated within 20 days of the date of the BSE (if entry is made prior to 20 days of the date of the BSE, this can be submitted separately or presented at the event)
- Copies of OFA certificates:
 - Hips: OFA Good or Fair at 24 months or older
 - Elbows: OFA Normal or DJD 1 at 24 months or older (Normal strongly recommended)
 - Heart: OFA Normal at 24 months or older
 - Eyes: OFA Certification # at 24 months or older (Normal strongly recommended) and eye certification must be dated within 3 years prior to the date of the BSE
 - CHIC #
 - JLPP: DNA testing for the genetic mutation known to cause Juvenile Laryngeal Paralysis & Polyneuropathy (JLPP) must be performed and recorded with OFA. Dogs who are JLPP clear by parentage must show both sire and dam recorded with OFA as clear by DNA test.
 - Dentition (optional): If dog is missing more than one tooth, OFA dentition certificate must be presented showing that the tooth was previously present.

ARC BSE entries will be accepted first with a max limit of 15 and must meet ARC Mandatory Practices and ARC rules. If the max limit is not reached by 6/9/2025, ADRK BSE entries that meet ADRK World Family requirements will be accepted until the max limit of 15 is reached.

Dogs that pass the ARC BSE will also be eligible for the ADRK BSE certification.

ONLY ARC BSE's that pass will receive the ARC BSE Medallion and will be eligible for the ARC BSE Parent Club Title that will be recognized and issued by the American Kennel Club (AKC). Passing ARC BSE's can be submitted to AKC with an application fee to receive the Title recognition on your AKC Registration!
