AIRK Requirements for Entries

Regular Classes

Only Rottweilers with a valid recognized registration, from AKC, CKC, or any FCI member Kennel Club) may participate in AIRK shows, with the exception of the Exhibition Only Class.

Puppy and Youth Classes:

- Puppies and Youth dogs must enter the age-appropriate class as of THE DAY of showing.
i.e. 4-6, 6-9, 9-12, 12-18, 18-24 months.
- 4 to 6-month-old puppies may be entered with an AKC litter registration number if their individual registration has not been issued yet.

Adult Classes:

- Dogs must be 24 months or more for all adult classes; OPEN, CHAMPION, BREEDERS, WORKING, VETERAN, SIEGER/IN.
- **Open:** For all Rottweilers 24 months and older
- **Breeders:** for dogs being exhibited by their breeder. (Not necessarily the owner). This is NOT a BBE as in AKC.
- **Champion:** The dog must be a Champion of a country. (AKC, UKC, CKC, USRC, URKA, FCI).
- **Working:** Dogs with a working title. This title must represent an “assistance to mankind”
Most working titles qualify; however, titles that are pass or fail and/or are not scored, or competitive, such as CGC’s, PT, HIT, Trick Dog, etc. do not qualify for the Working class. If you're not sure, contact us.
- **Sieger & Siegerin:** For dogs with a recognized Sieger or Siegerin title. (ARC, USRC, ARV, URKA, RKNA, or FCI). If you're not sure, contact us.

• If a dog has a recognized Sieger or Siegerin Title they **MUST** enter the Sieger/in Class.

• **Veteran:** Dogs must be 7 (seven) years of age or older on the day of the show.

Non-regular classes include Kennel Class, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Exhibition Only Classes.

- **Kennel Class:** A minimum of three dogs representing the kennel breeding program. Must include progeny from two different litters & individual dogs must be entered in regular classes.
- **Stud Dog Class:** Three progeny from two different litters. Progeny must be entered in regular classes.
- **Brood Bitch Class:** Two progeny from two different litters. Progeny must be entered in regular classes. (Note that it is not necessary for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch to be entered in the regular class.)
- **Exhibition Only:** These are for critique only. This class is open to all Rottweilers, even those with a disqualifying fault or who are spayed, neutered, or too young to be entered in puppy class. No ratings or placements are to be awarded. Dogs are critiqued with fault(s) noted. This class is for educational purposes only.

All dogs entered in Regular Adult classes, that are 30 months of age or older, must list their Hip rating (all other health testing is encouraged as well). After 30 months of age “pending” will not be allowed concerning hip ratings. The dog must either have a hip rating or a 0 will be used.

No person under suspension with the AKC may participate in any AIRK event.

AIRK - BSE (Breed Standard Evaluation)

The AIRK Breed Standard Evaluation (BSE) is an evaluation that verifies that the Rottweiler conforms to the FCI Standard for the Rottweiler in type and in temperament and is free of disqualifying faults. The evaluated dog must be of sound temperament, show tractability and eagerness to work. The traits of character assessed should reveal high confidence of character, sociable behavior, and the aptitude of a utility dog. The dog should be healthy in body and mind, with a self-assured nature, well-balanced nerves, and a high stimulus threshold.

Entry Requirements:

- A valid AKC, CKC, or any FCI member Kennel Club registration is required
- The dog must be microchipped
- The dog must have a weight certificate dated within 30 days of the AIRK-BSE.
- Copies of the dog's Registration Certificate, Health Certificates, and Scorebook (if applicable) must be submitted with the dog's entry.
- The originals of the dog's Registration, Health Certificates, and Scorebook (if applicable) must be presented to the secretary upon check-in.
- The dog must have recognized health certification for Hips, Elbows, Cardiac, and JLPP (OFA, ADRK, FCI).
- Accepted Hip Ratings are OFA: Excellent, Good, or Fair, ADRK: HD-, HD +/-, HD+, or FCI: HD A or B.
- Accepted Elbow Ratings: OFA: Normal, Grade I or II, ADRK: ED Free, ED+/-, ED+ or FCI: ED 0 or ED 1
- The dog must have a Rating of Normal (OFA) or Unaffected (FCI)
- The dog must have a JLPP certificate (Clear or Carrier)

Evaluation of Conformation and Character:

- Identification: The dog's microchip number will be verified. This is an essential part of the test, and the dog must allow itself to be touched by the judge.
- Measurement/Dentition/Eyes: Using a wicket, measuring tape, eye chart, and a skull measuring device, measurements of the dog's height, body length, chest circumference, and skull will be taken and recorded as well as the eye color, and dentition.
- Conformation: A complete written critique and rating of the dog's conformation and movement as evaluated by the FCI breed standard will be recorded.
- Temperament, Social Behavior and Impartiality:
 - Reaction to Gunfire: The handler and dog walk away from the judge. At a distance of fifteen paces, a 22 short blank starter pistol, or its equivalent, is fired twice with a short interval in between each shot. Should the dog have an unacceptable reaction to the gunfire, this exercise may be varied and repeated at the judge's discretion. If the dog continues to show a strong unacceptable reaction to gunfire, the evaluation will be terminated.
 - With the dog on a leash the handler and dog walk through a group of five to eight people. The handler and dog return to the center of the group where the dog sits. The group, when instructed by the judge, converges on the dog and handler, and remains there until told by the judge to disperse. Minor deviations to the test routine may occur under the judge's discretion.
 - The handler will walk dog through a line of people at which time the judge will shake a bottle of rocks or similar item, they will walk back through a second time and halt at the judge's direction. This part of the evaluation is to assess noise sensitivity and reaction and recovery from a sudden noise.

The judge may choose to add or repeat any elements of the test as they see fit to properly evaluate the dog's character and temperament.

If the dog is found free of disqualifying faults under the FCI Standard for the Rottweiler and passed the temperament portion of the evaluation, the dog will be awarded the title of: AIRK – BSE
